As part of the submission process for CURJ, we ask that you provide us with confirmation of faculty (supervisor) involvement with the research process. This does not have to take the form of collaborative research, but it should ensure that a faculty member has read, or attended to, the research objective and product of the student submission. For an interdisciplinary journal, this certifies that methodological correctness is maintained across disciplines, since it allows for specialists to confirm the validity of the approach taken by students.

All student submissions are closely reviewed and analyzed by Columbia student editors and also undergo a peer review process with impartial referees. During the review process, CU editors will work with authors on content, structure, and copy-editing issues to ensure each author's research article reaches its full potential.
