(formerly referred to as Center Coordinator of Clinical Education (CCCE))

Clinical Experience- refers to full-time experience in which a student is engaged for a minimum of 35 hours per week and supervised by a Clinical Instructor (formerly referred to as internship)

Academic Institution- University or college through which an academic degree is granted.

Clinical Education Site (Site)- A health service delivery agency or other setting in which clinical education experiences are provided for physical therapist or physical therapist assistant students
